

Guidelines for Parents/Carers

Barrowford Celtic are held responsible by the Football Association for the behaviour of the players and spectators before, during and after the game. Our club will be disciplined by the FA or League for any incidents reported to them by the Referee involving players or spectators.

Parents/Carers Must.

- 1 – Do not coach from the sidelines, however the club does appreciate positive encouragement to ALL players.
- 2 – The decisions of match officials must not be questioned.
- 3 – Never become involved in arguments with match officials, opposing players or officials or other spectators.
- 4 – Please appreciate the effort and skill of the players. Try not to expect young players to perform like stars. Inconsistency is all part of the ‘growing up’ process associated with young players.
- 5 – Please try to minimise any nuisance to residents in the vicinity of matches (eg excessive noise, inconsiderate parking, dropping of litter).
- 6 – Please remember our coaches give up many hours of free time to take the responsibility of coaching your child. Please respect this.
- 7 – All disputes regarding the behaviour of officials opposing players, officials and spectators is the responsibility of the team coach who will follow official procedures for the registration of a complaint.
- 8 – Ensure your child is suitably kitted out for the conditions during training sessions.
